Not only that, Preachers served Steve the best burger he has ever eaten, and the food at the other two is also great. The fact they are located within walking distance of API's comfortable, two-bedroom unit in historic Battery Point, had him in raptures. I am not sure if Steve or his wife (I affectionately refer to her as the Saint - you will know why after talking to Steve for just 5 minutes) found their way into the kitchen of the unit, because they also enjoyed meals at **Kathmandu** Cuisine, Kosaten (Japanese), Da Angelo (Italian) and apparently consumed the best seafood pie at **Shippies (The Shipwright Arms)**. All located within Battery Point itself. With remarkable stamina, Steve and the Saint also managed breakfast, along with cakes, at the Jackman & Ross bakery, also in Battery Point, at 57 Hampden Road.

So, how do I know all about Steve's dining experiences? Steve called to let me know he had taken my advice to book some trips using both **Experience Oz** and **RedBalloon**. **RedBalloon** offers eGift cards purchased from the
